How to Apply

Why go?

ADK LT is a 9-week, discipleship experience you will remember and cherish for a lifetime. Leadership is a skill needed for all aspects of life - from careers to families to communities.

The world is in dire need of Christian leaders. Biblically-based leadership is service-oriented, character-based, and interdependent. equipping in leadership and service.



The program includes national speakers challenging students in many areas of Christian leadership and discipleship. We have “Teams,” which are made up of 10-15 people who will spend one day a week in spiritual formation, equipping in leadership and service. Our goal is to provide as many practical leadership experiences as possible. It is a “hands-on” program.



Where Does The Program Take Place?

Silver Bay, New York is located within the beautiful Adirondack Mountains. The YMCA is located on Lake George where you can swim, canoe, kayak, sail, and more! There are hiking trails to go on adventures with friends and connect with God in His creation.

How Does Employment Work?

Silver Bay YMCA employs our participants and houses them in their dorms. Compensation includes food and housing plus approximately \$450 pre-tax per week in additional wages for 40 work hours. We offer training to help you raise support for your food and housing costs so you can get full paychecks without deducting room and board!

When?

The program dates are June 13th through August 17th.

Who?

You will be with college students around the country who come from churches in the Collegiate Church Network. Staff from Reliant Mission will provide leadership training and pastoral care. Lastly, in your job at the YMCA, you will work alongside employees from around the world. It is a cross-cultural experience!

How Much?

The cost of Collegiate Adirondack LT is \$995 unless you apply early or are a returner to LT. You will also need to get there on your own dime (aka plane ticket, gas money).

Participants pay some at the beginning and make payments through the summer. Support raising for this leadership training is highly encouraged.
